## Manly Warringah Cycling Club Rules

- 1. The name of the organisation is Manly Warringah Cycling Club Inc.
- 2. All members must abide by the rules of the NSW Cycling Federation
- 3. All members must abide by the Police and Traffic Laws as per the RTA Road Users Handbook
- 4. The management of this Club is vested in a committee of the following office bearers and members:
  - a. President
  - b. Vice President
  - c. Treasurer
  - d. Secretary
  - e. And three committee members
- 5. Any committee member failing to attend three meetings without an apology forfeits their place on the committee
- 6. The AGM is held in November each year
- 7. The official cub colours are decided by the Committee and are submitted and ratified by the **NSW** Cycling Federation
- 8. The financial year of the Club is 1 December to November 30
- 9. Membership fees are set a minimum of \$10 above the Australian Cycling Federation for each grade, and may be increased at the discretion of the Committee
- 10. Race entry fees are set at the discretion of the committee
- 11. Any member who in the opinion of the committee has during an official race or training session behaved in a manner prejudicial to the sport will be dealt with by the Committee, which decision is final.
- 12. All race entry money after expenses is to be paid into the Club's General account. 40% of the entry money is to be set aside for future projects
- 13. Cheques must be signed by any two of the office bearers mentioned in Rule 4
- 14. The treasurer is required to submit monthly reports to the committee
- 15. All Life Members have the equivalent of a non-competitive membership to Cycling Australia paid for by the Club
- 16. All Life Members are accorded the same rights and privileges as other members
- 17. Grading: The Point score system for A, B, C and D grade is on a promotion system.
  - a. To move up a grade a rider must accumulate 15 points in a season
  - b. Points are awarded on the following basis

    - i. 1st 6 Points ii.  $2^{nd} 4$  points
    - iii.  $3^{rd} 3$  points
- 18. Riders wishing to leave the Club must obtain Clearance from the Club Secretary
- 19. Only Committee members may receive money on behalf of the Club and must be forwarded to the Treasurer in 7 days
- 20. No alteration of these rules may be made without a written request to the Secretary at least 14 days prior to an AGM or Special general meeting then passed by two thirds majority of the members present at the AGM
- 21. The Committee has the Power to decide all questions not provided for in the rules
